SUMMARY

The 2020 tax rate of \$19.87 per thousand of assessed valuation is slightly higher than the 2019 rate of \$19.75. The net 2020 tax levy after applying credits totaling \$131,006.64 is \$5,306.01 less than the 2019 tax levy of \$135,700.63. The 2020 assessed value of the Village total is \$82,365,800.00.

REAL ESTATE TAXES

You must pay at least one half of your real estate taxes and the entire balance of all special assessments and special charges on or before January 31, 2021. The second half of your real estate taxes must be received by the Manitowoc County Treasurer on or before July 31, 2021, at the Courthouse in the City of Manitowoc. The lottery credit for 2020 only applies to property you own that was used as your primary residence on January 1, 2020. If property you claim as your primary residence does not have a lottery credit on it and you feel you qualify for it, please contact village office. The lottery credit for qualifying tax bills in 2020 is \$147.62 compared to \$167.65 received in 2019. The first dollar credit for most parcels with improvements is \$60.23 for 2020 compared to \$60.42 for 2019.

PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES

Personal property taxes must be paid in full on or before January 31, 2021.

TAX COLLECTION

Please make all checks payable to the "Village of Mishicot". Please return the first payment stub for each tax bill you are paying. Taxes may also be paid at the village hall Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Tuesday and Thursday from 9:00 a.m. till noon. The Village Hall will be closed all day on Thursday, December 24, 2020, and closed all day Friday, December 25, 2020, and will be closed from 12:00 noon until 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 31, 2020, and all day on Friday, January 1, 2021. Drop box payments over the holiday weekend and collected at 9:00 a.m. on January 4 will be credited to December 31, 2020, unless specifically requested otherwise. **IF YOU WANT A RECEIPT PLEASE PUT SELF ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE ALONG WITH YOUR TAX PAYMENT.**

IMPORTANT NOTICE - DOGS

STATE LAW REQUIRES ALL DOGS TO BE LICENSED YEARLY. Proof of current rabies inoculation must be presented before dog licenses will be issued. The license fee is \$5.00 for neutered males or spayed females and \$10.00 for unneutered males or un-spayed females. **OWNERS CAN BE FINED FOR FAILURE TO LICENSE A DOG YEARLY.** All unlicensed dog owners get forwarded to the Manitowoc County District Attorney's Office if dog license is not paid by April 1, 2021.

WATER SYSTEM CROSS CONNECTION PROGRAM

During 2010 the Village of Mishicot initiated a water system cross connection control program to ensure that water quality for customers of the Mishicot Water Utility continues to be maintained at the highest standards in the industry. These inspections will be required on all residential dwellings once in a ten-year period and will be scheduled well in advance at the convenience of property owners. There may be occasions where potential water system cross connections need to be corrected by the property owner, but there will be no charges from the Village for the inspection services. We welcome any questions you have regarding our continuing efforts to protect your water quality.

SEWER SYSTEM INCREASE OF 1.1%

The Volume charge for the sewer is going from \$8.30 per thousand gallons to \$8.39 per thousand gallons, this will take effect as of January 1, 2021. This increase is due to new debt and other charges.
