#### **SUMMARY**

The 2021 tax rate of \$19.87 per thousand of assessed valuation is the same as the 2020 rate of \$19.87. The net 2021 tax levy after applying credits totaling \$130,244.64 is \$12,909.16 more than the 2020 tax levy of \$1,636,318.05. The 2021 assessed value of the Village total is \$82,986,000, an increase of \$620,200 over the 2020 assessed value of \$82,365,800.

#### **REAL ESTATE TAXES**

You must pay at least one half of your real estate taxes and the entire balance of all special assessments and special charges on or before January 31, 2022. The second half of your real estate taxes must be received by the Manitowoc County Treasurer on or before July 31, 2022, at the Courthouse in the City of Manitowoc. The lottery credit for 2021 only applies to property you own that was used as your primary residence on January 1, 2021. If property you claim as your primary residence does not have a lottery credit on it and you feel you qualify for it, please contact village office. The lottery credit for qualifying tax bills in 2021 is \$212.95 compared to \$147.62 received in 2020. The first dollar credit for most parcels with improvements is \$60.04 for 2021 compared to \$60.23 for 2020.

### **PERSONAL PROPERTY TAXES**

Personal property taxes must be paid in full on or before January 31, 2022.

# **TAX COLLECTION**

Please make all checks payable to the "Village of Mishicot". Please return the first payment stub for each tax bill you are paying. Taxes may be paid by mail, at the village hall Monday, Wednesday, and Friday from 9:00 a.m. to 5:00 p.m., and Tuesday and Thursday from 9:00a.m. till noon or dropped in the drop box outside Village Hall. The Village Hall will be closed all day on Thursday and Friday, December 23-24, 2021, and will be closed from 12:00 noon until 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, December 30, 2021, and all day on Friday, December 31, 2021. Drop box payments over the holiday weekend and collected at 9:00 a.m. on January 3 will be credited to December 31, 2021, unless specifically requested otherwise. IF YOU WANT A RECEIPT, PLEASE PUT A SELF ADDRESSED STAMPED ENVELOPE ALONG WITH YOUR TAX PAYMENT.

### **IMPORTANT NOTICE – DOGS**

STATE LAW REQUIRES ALL DOGS TO BE LICENSED <u>YEARLY</u>. Proof of current rabies inoculation must be presented before dog licenses will be issued. The license fee is \$5.00 for neutered males or spayed females and \$10.00 for unneutered males or un-spayed females. There will be a \$25 late fee for all dogs licensed after May 1, 2022. **OWNERS CAN BE FINED FOR FAILURE TO LICENSE A DOG YEARLY**.

## WATER SYSTEM CROSS CONNECTION PROGRAM

During 2010 the Village of Mishicot initiated a water system cross connection control program to ensure that water quality for customers of the Mishicot Water Utility continues to be maintained at the highest standards in the industry. These inspections will be required on all residential dwellings once in a ten-year period and will be scheduled well in advance at the convenience of property owners. There may be occasions where potential water system cross connections need to be corrected by the property owner, but there will be no charges from the Village for the inspection services. We welcome any questions you have regarding our continuing efforts to protect your water quality.
