RESOLUTION 2023-02

RESOLUTION ON WATER AND SEWER ADJUSTMENT POLICY

WHEREAS, the Village of Mishicot from time to time receives complaints of customers receiving an unusually large water and sewer bill. This resolution creates a policy where the Village may give a credit to those affected by a leak in their plumbing.

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED, by the Board of Trustees of the Village of Mishicot, Manitowoc County, Wisconsin, by this resolution, adopted by a majority of the village board on a roll call vote with a quorum present and voting and proper notice having been given, resolves and declares as follows:

In the event of a water and sewer customer having an extremely high bill due to a leak, if the bill is more than 25% higher than the previous bill, this policy consists of averaging the last three years' bills for the same quarter in question and calculating a credit of \$6.82 per 1,000 gallons of excess water for a sewer credit. This policy would also require the resident to present receipts that the leak has been identified and repaired in order to qualify for the credit. In the event that the rate the Village pays to the City of Two Rivers changes, this credit will also change by the same amount. The current rate paid is \$1.32 per 1,000 gallons.
